in a Research Study being conducted  
at Colorado State University.**

Researchers from the Integrative Neurophysiology Laboratory are investigating whether transcranial direct current stimulation improves motor function and fatigue resistance in people with MS. The study consists of 2 sessions where your leg strength or muscle fatigability will be tested. To find out if you qualify for the study you can fill out a short online questionnaire. Within a few days of completion, one of our research staff will contact you to confirm your eligibility.
